

DISTRICT 2 BUSINESS MEETING

OCTOBER 13, 2011

PRESENT: Victor, Skip, Mike, David, Royce, David, Sandy, and Layla

Royce opened the meeting with a moment of silence followed by the Serenity Prayer. The 10th Tradition was read by Royce.

Sandy passed out copies of the Secretary's report. It was accepted as given.

Art discussed the Treasurer's report. Beginning balance was \$959.24. Received funds were \$150.00. Expenses were: \$143.27. Ending balance minus 'prudent reserve' was \$665.97. This report was accepted.

CPC-Layla reported that the monologue for ETSU was moved to November. She is working with Dr. Ron Baisden, professor at ETSU. She also has many other service opportunities available. Contact her for information.

OLD BUSINESS:

She will bring the shirts to the 4th Quarter Assembly in Nashville.(She didn't because of illness.)

NEW BUSINESS: Art reported that we are starting to have banking expenses due to the fact that our balance has fallen below \$1000.00. The incoming Treasurer will need to get with Art for the transfer of monies and checkbook.

Royce requested that he be reimbursed after the 4th quarter assembly for his DCM expenses. This passed. Mike S. motioned and it was seconded by Sandy that the DCM bring back a report from each assembly for all those GSR's who didn't attend to know what happened. This motion passed.

A motion was made and tabled to move the District elections to October, beginning in 2013, to keep with Area 64 Structure. Moving the elections would enable the Secretary to get the incoming GSR's and DCM information to AREA 64 and also GSO so that these places can have the changes and get the necessary information to the incoming people. This was tabled until the November meeting.

Motion made and seconded to have the Secretary send an e-mail reminding all GSR's of upcoming meetings for the district. This passed. Secretary will send an e-mail for the November meeting to all those we have addresses for.
